

Liberty Band PARENT Commitment Letter

My child, _____ plans to participate in the Liberty Bands Winter program.

- I understand my child is required to attend all rehearsals.
- I understand my child is part of a team and thus needs to be at all performances and competitions.
- I understand that my child must be kind, courteous and respectful to all team members, coaches, program organizers and parent volunteers.
- I understand absences must be communicated at least two weeks in advance by a written note/email to the Winter Program Coaches.
- I understand my student will stay at all competitions through the end of the day and will be dismissed as a group at the school by the coach.
- I understand that I need to pay the required Liberty Band Booster Participation fees in full by the end of the season (April 9) in order for the Band Boosters to pay staff, required competition entry fees, provide food, uniforms, props and equipment for my student.
- I understand that discounted fees are available to families who contribute to the program by volunteering to drive for two can drives and complete 20 other adult volunteer hours per season that my child participates in (Fall Marching season and/or Winterguard/Winter Percussion season). If I wish to opt out of volunteering my fees will be \$400 higher. For families committing to the volunteering discount, any shortfall from the required 20 hours per season will be billed at rate of \$20/hour against my student's account and could affect their ability to participate in end of year activities.
- I understand my student will be required to contribute to the program by participating in general fundraisers, including 5 can drives, and one shift at any other general fundraiser. I understand my fees will be higher if these commitments are not met.
