BAND CAMP DETAILS

Percussion Camp Daily Schedule: 9 am - 8 pm Wed-Fri Aug 7th - 9th

Band Camp Daily Schedule: 9 am – 8 pm Mon-Fri Aug 12-16 and Mon-Sat Aug 19-24

- Wed. August 7th (First day of Percussion Camp):
 - All students wanting to participate as part of percussion should attend percussion camp
- Mon. August 12th (First day of Full Camp):
 - Parents register their students Mon Aug 12 from 8:00-9:30am at the Registration Table
 - All students (new and returning) must check in at the Registration Table even If you have already dropped off all your forms and payment
- Thu. August 15th:
 - Parent informational night with Q&A **7pm**. Opportunity for parents to meet/reconnect before the season gets into full swing; boosters will provide snacks/treats. **Students will still be practicing.**
- Fri. August 16th:
 - Student Taco Night Liberty Band Boosters provides buffet style taco dinner (students still bring lunch)
- Sat. August 24th (Last Day of Camp):
 - Show preview for parents. There will be a potluck after the preview. Will send out a signup for side dishes. Booster will serve Hamburgers and hotdogs hot from the grill!

Meals:

- Bring a durable water bottle every day ideally 64 oz or two 32-oz bottles
 - Students need to bring their own lunch and dinner except for the first Friday (Aug 19th): Liberty Band Boosters provide dinner (students still bring lunch)
 - Students are working hard for long days. Pack enough food!
- No refrigerator access bring your own small cooler if needed

Transportation:

• No transportation is provided. Parents can try to negotiate carpools amongst themselves.

Other things to bring: (all covered in more detail in the handbook – see website link above):

- Water! So important!
- Athletic shoes
- Dot book / Notebook (3x5 spiral notebook)
- Be ready for the weather you will be outside much of the day sunscreen, hat, even sweatshirt/raincoat, whatever the weather calls for
- Wear deodorant. These are long, often hot days. Your fellow band members and staff will thank you.
- 3-ring binder and sheet protectors. (a 1-inch binder will do)

Fall Marching Season 2024

PRACTICES:

Regular practices are held at Liberty HS Mon/Wed, 6-9 p.m., Aug. 26th – Oct. 30th. It is critical that every student attends the full Band Camp and every practice. Additional practices might be added during the season. Transportation to/from practices is not provided. Carpooling is highly encouraged. Please discuss any conflicts with the Band Director, Mr. Soon.

COMPETITIONS:

This year we have tentatively scheduled **Saturday competitions from Oct. 5th through Nov 2nd** including the possibility of one **or more overnight trips**. The schedule is still being finalized so stay tuned.

We will be hosting the Liberty Marching Arts Challenge on **Nov. 2, 2024**, at the Hillsboro Stadium. This is also the A and AA Marching Band Championships. This will be an all-hands-on-deck volunteering event as we will both be running the whole event and participating in it as well.

Students are expected to participate in every competition. The band generally performs twice at each competition. The schedule for each competition day is announced about one week before that competition. The time of the second performance is dependent on preliminary performance scores. Plan for long, fun days!

Band students also participate in **Pep Band**, playing at home football games and selected basketball games.

FEES:

Hillsboro School District Activity fee: this fee is charged by the school district. Please note that the HSD activity fee is <u>separate</u> from the LBB fees and must be paid to the school. Due to recent changes to the HSD lunch program, HSD has changed how students qualify for free or reduced cost activities fees. Please visit the following page for more details:

LBB fees: These fees are payable to Liberty Band Boosters and outlined in the registration packet for Fall 2024.

UNIFORMS:

Liberty Band Boosters provides one "Better Every Day" T-shirt free to new students. **Students are responsible for purchasing marching shoes** (the Boosters coordinate an order in August) and **black socks** (one pair black socks provided with each pair of new shoes). Uniforms are maintained by the Boosters, assigned to each student, kept at school.

INSTRUMENTS:

Some **Marching Band** instruments are provided by the band and must be well taken care of by the students. Some **Concert Band** instruments are also provided by the band. The rest are the student's responsibility.

FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENT:

General fundraisers help offset the actual cost of participation and cover a variety of expenses. Liberty Band hosts two major events during the year, LMAC and LWC. New for 2023: There is no longer separate volunteering hours and fundraising hours. Families are required to help at a minimum of one LBB fundraising events per year, LMAC or LWC. There is no opt-out. See the Fundraising Info sheet for more info and other fundraising opportunities.

Individual fundraisers benefit your student's Band account directly. These are optional; however we strongly encourage those that are receiving a scholarship to participate in individual fundraising opportunities. With individual fundraising a family can offset participation fees. These opportunities will vary from year to year, but examples of past opportunities include: pie sale fundraisers, working shifts at the OSAA soccer or LSI basketball tournament at Liberty and finding and securing sponsorships.

- I understand my child needs to attend the full band camp which is tentatively scheduled for 9 a.m. 8 p.m., Aug. 12-24.
- I understand my child is part of a team and thus needs to be at all performances of the Liberty Marching Band and Colorguard program including football games and weekend competitions. I understand excused absences must be communicated at least two weeks in advance by a written note/email to Mr. Soon.
- I understand my child will stay at all competitions through the end of day and will be dismissed as a group by Mr. Soon.
- I understand that I need to pay the required Liberty Band Booster participation fees by the end of the season (Nov. 15, Winter: Apr. 15) for the Band Boosters to pay staff, required competition entry fees, and provide food, uniforms, props and equipment for my student.
- I understand that discounted fees are available if I commit to completing 32 adult volunteer hours per season that my child participates in (fall and/or winter). For families committing to the volunteering discount, any shortfall from the required 32 hours per season will be billed at rate of \$20/hour against my student's account.
- I understand that Liberty Band Booster relies on general fund fundraising events such as, Liberty Marching Arts Challenge and Liberty Winter Classic. I understand that my participation in general fundraiser events is required including a minimum of one shift(s) at a general fund fundraiser event per year.
- I understand my child will be required to contribute to the program by participating in general fund fundraisers including five can drives and one shift at any other general fund fundraiser.

- Equipment/food loading and transporting (Fri night)
- Truck driver (rental co., to Liberty, to competition and back)
- Trailer hauler (haul little blue trailer to/from competition)

- Tent city setup (8-10 people) (Saturday morning)

- Scholarship amounts awarded will be based on budgeted funds divided by the number of eligible scholarship applicants at the conclusion of the season.
- Scholarship families are required to meet the volunteering commitment. However, we understand this is not always possible for all families and we will consider all applications.
- Scholarship families will receive an invoice at the beginning of the season showing the total commitment required and again after scholarship funds have been applied. Volunteer hours will be applied to reduce the total amount throughout the year.
