

WINTER PERCUSSION 2024-25

Liberty Winter Percussion is an extracurricular ensemble that begins rehearsals in late-November and performs and competes into April. The focus of this group is to develop and refine upper-level percussion techniques in a dedicated medium. There are two evening rehearsals a week, Monday & Wednesday 5:00 - 9:00 pm and we might add an occasional Saturday rehearsal. This ensemble is open to students from either concert ensemble as well as the Liberty student body at large.

EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Attendance is required at all rehearsals and competitions. Please discuss any conflicts with the Percussion Director, Ryan Tai (ryantaipercussion@gmail.com).
- 2. Parent volunteers are needed for each competition.
- 3. Parent volunteers may need to help during competitions with pushing instruments, floor placement or removal, and props.
- 4. Additional parent volunteer roles will be announced. Watch for communications for volunteer needs throughout the season (SignUpGenius).
- 5. All families are expected to work at least one shift at a LBB fundraising event. We have one remaining event this year, Liberty Winter Classic, Winterguard Championships, on March 29th, 2025 at Liberty HS.

COST/VOLUNTEER HOURS

- 1. Cost: \$450 registration fee. Families are also required to commit to 32-hour of volunteering. If the volunteer commitment is not fulfilled, then unmet hours at the end of the season will be billed to student's account at \$20/hour. Families can opt-out of the volunteer commitment by paying the full amount, additional \$640, at the start of the season.
- 2. There is an additional commitment of volunteering at least one shift at a LBB hosted events. This can be completed by volunteering at LMAC (Nov 2nd, 2024) or LWC (March 29th, 2025).
- 3. There is a scholarship option for families that meet the district criteria for reduced activities fees.
- 4. See registration form for more details.

GOOD TO KNOW

- 1. Buses will be provided for transportation to and from the shows.
- 2. Meals will be provided based on performance times. Parent volunteers to prep and serve food.
- 3. Parent volunteer help may be needed with building of props.

^{*}The registration fee is the minimum fee to participate in the season. The full participation fee is the registration fee plus any unfulfilled volunteer hours, which are charged at \$20/hr. Any unfilled volunteer hours are charged to the students account at the end of the season. Volunteering hours can be met by participation in events throughout the season or by paying all or a portion of the opt-out fee. If you have concerns about meeting volunteer hours, talk to our VP of Volunteering or any of the LBB board members. There are always opportunities to assist outside of those published in SignUpGenius.

Families that join after a season starts may have reduced fees, depending on when they join. This reduction shall only be applied the first time a family joins their first season (fall or winter). All future seasons will have no additional reduction regardless of when they join. Volunteering commitments may also be reduced, based on time of joining. A refund may be possible if a student decided to or cannot continue. Please reach out to a board member or Mr. Soon if this situation occurs.

^{*}Can drives count toward the general volunteer hours. Items that pay money into student's account, such as individual fundraisers, HOPs, Sponsorship, OSAA Soccer, etc. do not count toward the general volunteer hours but can be applied to fees or unmet volunteer hours.

** Minimum of one shift at an LBB hosted event per calendar year. This is separate from volunteering hours. If not met, a 4 hour shift will be charged to the student's account at \$20/hour.

Winter Payment Plans:

- 1. Payment in full assuming full volunteering: \$450 minus any discounts due on Dec 1, 2024
- 2. Half Payments assuming full volunteering: \$225 minus any discounts due on **Dec 1, 2024**. Remaining **\$225** or any balance remaining after any personal fundraisers due by **April 15, 2025**
- **3. Quarter Payments assuming full volunteering:** \$115 minus any discounts due on **Dec 1, 2024**. Pay at least 1/3 of remaining balance each month after. Any remaining balance after any personal fundraisers due by **April 15, 2025**
- 4. Payment in full including volunteering opt-out: (\$1090 minus any discounts, due on Dec 1, 2024
- 5. Scholarship: For families that meet the HSD waiver/reduction activities fees program. The scholarship form is due with the rest of the paperwork. If this form is not on file for the current season, participation charges will go on the student's account. Students applying for scholarship funds are expected to participate in all individual fund account fundraisers to raise as much as they are able. Any funds raised will be for payment of fees.

My chil	d, plans to participate in the Liberty Bands Winter program.
•	I understand my child is required to attend all rehearsals.
•	I understand my child is part of a team and thus needs to be at all performances and competitions.
•	I understand that my child must be kind, courteous and respectful to all team members, coaches, program organizers and parent volunteers.
•	I understand absences must be communicated at least two weeks in advance by a written note/email to the Winter Program Coaches.
•	I understand my student will stay at all competitions through the end of the day and will be dismissed as a group at the school by the coach.
•	I understand that I need to pay the required Liberty Band Booster Participation fees in full by the end of the season (April 15 th) in order for the Band Boosters to pay staff, required competition entry fees, provide food, uniforms, props and equipment for my student.
•	I understand that there is a commitment of 32 family volunteer hours per season. For any unfulfilled hours, student's account will be billed at rate of \$20/hour. If multiple students from a single family are participating, this amount will be split across those students.
•	I understand that there is a one shift requirement per year at a hosted Liberty Band Booster event such as the Liberty Marching Arts Challenge or the Liberty Winter Classic. I understand that if I don't fulfil this requirement, my student's account will be billed for a four hour shift at rate of \$20/hour.
•	I understand my student will be required to contribute to the program by participating in general fundraisers, including 5 can drives (3 for winter season-only students).
